270 Kilometres of hiking trails from the hotel

One of the largest collections of edelweiss and gentian in Europe in our garden

Rules of behaviour Garden & Hotel

Groups larger than 5 people must be registered for tours.
Guided tours of the garden or the hotel are possible for groups of 5-25 people
are possible on advance booking from CHF 250.

Leaving the paths is not allowed

Picnics in the garden are not allowed.

Dogs must be kept on a lead and are not permitted in the gardens.

Picking flowers is strictly forbidden on the Schatzalp.

Seed and plant theft or the removal of labels and flowers will be penalised with a CHF 200.00
processing fee. If the damage is higher, a report will be made.
